Kent Cornucopia Days is a Community Project of the Kent Lions. South King County's largest Family Festival celebrating its 45th year in 2016. Nearly 200,000 people attend this SEAFair event that benefits over 250 non-profit organizations. One of the Northwest's largest street fairs with 400 vendors, parade, food court, 2 stages of entertainment, health & safety fairs, educational displays, art shows, and much more. Event also includes the Cornucopia Cup Soccer Tournament, the Kent Cornucopia Dragon Boat Races at Lake Meridian, and the Cornucopia 5K Fun Run/Walk.



The Kent Farmers Market is another project of the Kent Lions. This market is one of the oldest markets in King County, and is held at Town Square Plaza Park. Presenting up to 60 vendors each Saturday from June through September.
